New Street Baptist Church is in New Street, St Neots, on the corner of New Street and Tebbutts Road.

The inscriptions were originally surveyed in 2000 by Lydia Pullen, re-surveyed by Sue Jarrett with the addition of the St Neots Old Cemetery in 2013, and checked again by Dave Jarrett in 2024/25.

# Memorials on the wall adjoining 20 New Street

In the faith of Jesus dying, All her woes for ever cease. There's no sorrow, sin or sighing In the world of endless peace: Joys eternal, Feast her happy spirit there.

# Memorials in the church

This beloved servant of God was the highly esteemed Pastor of the Particular Strict Baptist Church in this place for nearly 58 years. He was an able minister of the New Testament and labored abundantly at home among many other churches in town and country, God bearing witness with His Word to the joy of many souls. His whole ministry was characterized by a consistent, devout, and ardent attachment to the Doctrines of Sovereign and Distinguishing Grace ascribing all the Glory of Salvation to "God who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began."

# St Neots Old Cemetery

Some headstones and remains were removed from the Baptist cemetery to St Neots Old Cemetery in 1988.

Many of the inscriptions are now (2025) largely illegible.

In front of the other headstones is a relatively new one to mark the re-interment.
