


George Thomas **Day**, died of wounds in France September 2nd 1916, aged 22 years






Sergt Edward Sidney **Goodman**, R M L I, died from wounds received in action in the Dardanelles, June 8th 1915, aged 33 years










Walter **Newton**, killed in action in France September 15th 1916, aged 21 years


Sapper Arthur **Page**, Royal Engineers, died 23rd July 1917, aged 31 years, buried in Belgium




Frederick **Sharman**, killed in Ireland, 18th August 1920, aged 30 years


C S Major Alfred William **Smith**, London Regiment, killed in action in France, 31st March 1918, aged 36 years


